

Welcome to the Anaheim ICE 8-week Learn-To-Skate Program.

The following is an outline of our program that will help introduce you to some of our procedures and policies.

1st Day of Class:

- Plan on arriving at least 30 minutes early on the first day of class.
- Dress warmly - bring gloves or mittens.
- Check in at front skate counter to receive an admission sticker and skates.
 - Skates should fit snugly and be tied tightly.

Class Location:

- All classes are held on the Olympic rink.
- For all Monday, Tuesday and Thursday classes, your class will meet behind the coned off area at the designated starting time of your class.

For all Wednesday and Saturday classes, a display board will be placed next to the entrance of the rink. To find the location of your class: Find your class on the display board and look to the top of the column for which your class is located. You will see a Disney character. These same Disney characters have been placed along the rink-side glass. At the scheduled time, your class will meet on the ice under the Disney character listed on the display board.

7th Day of Class:

Testing day! Your child will be evaluated and receive a testing form. This form will indicate whether or not your child has mastered the maneuvers required to advance to the next level. Please note: Not all skaters will advance each semester.

Priority Registration:

After receiving your test form, you will save \$10.00 off the next series of classes by signing up for the next semester before the priority registration deadline.

8th Day of Class:

Bring-A-Guest Day! Your child may bring one guest with him/her to enjoy a complimentary day of skating at Anaheim ICE. Your guest will receive a complimentary group class which will take place at the same time as your child's scheduled class. Your guest is also invited to skate on the same public session that your child normally skates as part of his/her Learn-To-skate Package.

On the 8th and final day of class, all skaters will receive a certificate for completing an 8-week Learn-To-Skate session at Anaheim ICE. All skaters will receive this certificate whether or not they advance to the next level.

Make-up Classes:

Each skater is entitled to one (1) make-up class per 8-week semester. The make-up class must take place during the same 8-week semester in which the class was missed.

Free Skating:

In addition to the free practice your child will receive on lesson day, he/she is also entitled to 5 complimentary public skating admissions and skate rentals. These 5 free passes will expire on the last day of your 8-week semester. Your child may either use these passes for themselves or he/she may use them for friends and family members.

To redeem your 5 free passes, just come to any of our public sessions and let the front counter know you are enrolled in the Learn-To-Skate Program. You will be issued a public session sticker and rental skates for that public session. We will not be presenting you with any physical passes, but rather we will be keeping track of your free admissions on our computer system.
